<b>Adjectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• comparative and superlative (including mejor, peor, mayor, menor)</li> <li>• the suffix -ísimo</li> <li>• ordinal numbers above 10<sup>th</sup></li> <li>• cardinal numbers above 100</li> <li>• demonstrative</li> <li>• possessive (long forms)</li> <li>• adjectives of quantity</li> </ul>
