<b>Adjectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• changes of adjective position which influence meaning</li></ul>
<b>Verbs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• present subjunctive used in adjective clauses</li><li>• present subjunctive used in adverb clauses</li><li>• imperfect subjunctive</li><li>• if clauses</li><li>• future and conditional perfect</li><li>• present and past perfect subjunctive</li><li>• sequence of tenses</li></ul>
<b>Pronouns</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• relative pronouns</li><li>• reciprocal</li></ul>
