

National Spanish Examinations for Middle School

The Level **Pre01** Exam is designed for students in Grade 6 who

1. have just begun their study of Spanish
2. are taking Spanish as an enrichment class which most probably does not meet every day of the school year
3. will be enrolled in Spanish I-A next year where the curriculum most closely resembles the first half of a Spanish I high school curriculum

NOTE: If a student is enrolled in a course where the curriculum most closely resembles the first half of a Spanish I high school curriculum, then that student should be registered to take the Level 01 National Spanish Exam.
